With the federal government extending social distancing and state governments extending business closures through the beginning of May, we will continue to create virtual training and guided workouts for our students. While we understand our athletes will be disappointed, we look forward to a fresh start and to generating excitement for the 2021 season ahead! Should either The Summit or The Cheerleading Worlds decide to go to a virtual platform, ECE will participate. Due to gym closures and gathering limitations, video submission would be from a previous performance of the 2020 season.

ECE has discussed and will be implementing several changes going into next season. We are mindful of reducing costs and working to eliminate some costs that are less essential to our success. Our tryout dates will be pushed back several weeks, and all tryout info will be released this Monday.

Examples of some cost reductions include the following – reusing current uniforms for the upcoming season, less practice wear, recycling music / some choreography, reduced travel. Full details will be included in our 2020-2021 tryout packet. We know that most of your athletes want to be able to continue cheering, and we want to do all we can to make this a reality for our ECE families.

Everyone at ECE understands the disappointment of our graduating seniors, both in all-star cheer as well as senior year school functions, traditions, and ceremonies. We hope they understand the amount of consideration that went into our decisions. Hours of discussion over the last few weeks have gone into what we believe is the best decision for all ECE families and athletes. We look forward to seeing our graduating seniors thrive as they continue on in the next chapters of their lives.
